Do you know the signs?

The symptoms of biliary cancer can be vague and mistaken for other, less serious conditions. If you have any of these symptoms for a prolonged period, see your GP:



Symptoms



Fever and chills



Pale bowel motions



Loss of appetite



Darkened urine



Unexplained weight loss



Jaundice (yellowing of skin/eyes)



Pain on right side of abdomen



Nausea and/or vomiting



Itchy skin



Excessive tiredness



Notes for your GP appointment

- Describe your symptoms.
- How long have they been going on?
- Do you have family history of biliary cancer?
- Do you have an inflammatory condition like ulcerative colitis?

Ask your GP what the plan is for treating symptoms. If medication is prescribed, make a plan and time for your next appointment to reassess symptoms if still present.



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
