

Pancreatic Cancer Fact Sheet



- Over 630 New Zealanders are diagnosed with pancreatic cancer each year.
- At 12%, pancreatic cancer has one of the lowest 5 year survival rates.
- Pancreatic cancer is expected to be New Zealand's 4th biggest cause of cancer deaths by 2025.
- Incidence of pancreatic cancer is increasing by between 10 to 15% per annum in New Zealand.
